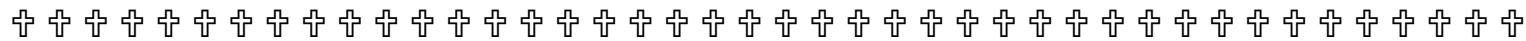

We'll meet at the church at 9:00 each morning and go on an adventure! Please let Kelly know if you can come.

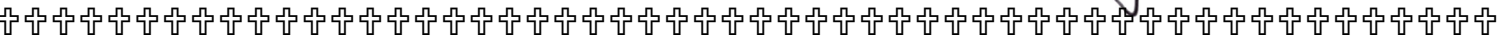
