
UMW Reading Program



Discipleship Path Plan

For about seven months we, as a church family, have been asked to pray for a team of people from our congregation as they work on developing a discipleship path plan. You may have some questions regarding our work and such a plan. The team is aware of this and desires to answer any questions that you may have. The following information will hopefully provide some answers to some basic questions. We are also planning an informational meeting that will be held during the Sunday School hour. This will be a time for the team to share, to receive questions, and for input from those who take part. The details about that gathering will be sent out soon. We are also planning other ways to communicate our work to you. You are invited and encouraged to read over the following information.

Why do we have a Discipleship Path team? Jesus gave the church its primary mission which is to make disciples (Matthew 28:18-20). The United Methodist Church has stated it this way. "Our mission is to make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world." Several years back our church adopted this as our official mission and mission statement. Last year the Church Council made the decision to pursue creating a plan that would help us as a congregation and as individuals to focus our efforts on fulfilling our mission. A team was formed, and we have been working toward that end.

Why is fulfilling our mission important? There are several reasons. We will bring glory to God. Jesus gave us the command to go and make disciples. It is in response to God's love for all people. Every person needs the Lord. Each person's eternal destiny is determined by his or her relationship to Jesus. The impact of following Jesus would change the world. We will help grow the Kingdom of God. You may have more reasons to add.

What is the goal of the team? The Discipleship Path team is working to develop a plan that is Biblical, practical, relevant, and applicable in guiding our ministry to fulfill our mission. It is a plan that will guide and encourage each of us as we seek to grow as followers of Jesus Christ.

What work has the team been doing? The team began with growing in our own understanding of our mission and the importance of fulfilling our mission. We have asked hard questions about our church's ministries to better understand how we are fulfilling our mission. We looked at some 120 ministries one by one. We have worked on a definition of what a disciple of Jesus Christ is. We have done all this with the aid of prayer, Bible study, and open, honest conversation. The work has not been easy at times, but it has been rewarding.

What will the discipleship path plan look like? At this time, we do not have a clear answer to this question. Some basic components of the plan will be

the description of a disciple and a guide to assist you in finding ministries that will help you to grow as a follower of Jesus Christ. This guide will assist ministries to evaluate their work and determine how they can take next steps in making disciples of Jesus Christ. All of this will be fulfilled through 5 primary practices that grow us as disciples: worship, service, witness, fellowship, and faith development. These remind us of our membership vows.

Who is on the team? David Rardin, Jo Sanders, Evadene Crumrin, Tiffany Macke, Rick Manuel, Nancy Claypool, Kyle Hutson, Becky Farrell, Barb Sabo, Angie Setzer, Jody Green, Charlie Moore, and Pastor Bob serve on the team. If you would be interested in joining the team in their work, please let Pastor Bob know. If you have questions, please feel free to talk to any of the team members.

When will the discipleship path be ready? We are unsure. We have made great progress, but there is still work to be done. It is not a fast process. We are working hard with intentionality and faith.

What can I do? Please pray for God's guidance and wisdom. Ask questions. Prayerfully support the team's work. Be open. Pray.
