Mission of the Month: Angie Broncano, Global Ministries Missionary to Laos

The confirmation class of Marshall First has been actively engaged in learning about our UMC, and this includes missionaries. The United Methodist Church has over 300 missionaries commissioned by the General Board of Global Ministries (GBGM) to serve from everywhere to everywhere. As you know, Connie Wieck is one of them. With Connie's help, our youth have connected with Angie Broncano, a GBGM missionary in Laos who is assigned to the English Program of the Sunbeam Language and Vocational Center, a Christian center. The confirmation class has been learning about Angie, and even hearing from the Laotian youth, during two virtual meetings on Zoom. Money was collected every week for Angie's suggested

mission project. Of the three proposals Angie mentioned, the youth decided to use the collected funds for educational support, set at \$50 per year (tuition

support, set at \$50 per year (tuition and supplies) for one primary or secondary student. Angie explained scholarships go first to Christian students of poor families, including pastors' children, but if more funding is available, this expands to non-Christians as well. The confirmation class collected \$111, which will sponsor 2 children, and would like to challenge our church family to join in giving additional funding to support 8 more.

The class members will explain more of this to the congregation on Confirmation Sunday, January 9. Please join with them in generously giving to the Laotian youth under Angie's guidance and care.


