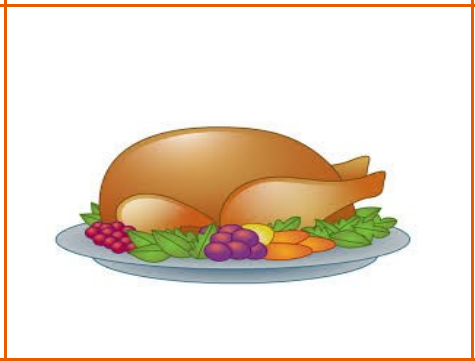

Mission Opportunities for November

1.) Living conditions for members of the Oglala Sioux Tribe who live on the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation in South Dakota are dreading the coming winter. Two of the most devastating winter-weather related events occurred this past late winter into spring. Winter storm Ulmer peaked on March 13th with 90 mile an hour winds and a blizzard. Then in mid-April, winter storm Wesley dumped an additional 20 inches of snow across the northern plains.

Thousands of miles of roads remained impassable after the heavy snow melt and more than a thousand people have extreme damage to their homes. The tribe has had to prove on its own the extent of the damage and is still accessing it with little help from FEMA. UMCOR and United Methodist churches are providing funds to help with the disaster assessments and with immediate needs of families that are still living in damaged homes in immediate need of repair without electricity and clean water.

You can help make the coming winter a little less daunting with your contributions. The Oklahoma Indian Missionary Conference is continuing to receive contributions for the Oglala Tribe. If you wish to contribute, make your check out to FUMC and we will forward your contribution to that conference to help repair homes and roads and to provide hygiene supplies for families of the Oglala Tribe.

2.) Locally, the Life Center of Clark County, an agency of East Central Illinois Area on Aging, is accepting donations of equipment for seniors such as walkers, and other devices needed by seniors who are handicapped. You can call the office at 217-826-5155 to find out what is needed and how you can help. The office is located in the brick building adjacent to the U of I Extension Building.

3.) As always, UMCOR and Midwest Distribution Center are giving local and national disaster relief and can always find a use for financial contributions. We can send your contributions from the church office.
