# Mission of the Month for September—Gas cards for Baby Fold

On August 7th, the first Sunday in August, Rev. Lori Bultimeir, Chaplain at the Baby Fold in Normal, II., spoke during Sunday worship. Baby Fold is celebrating 150 years of service by highlighting its 12 areas of service to families . Those services provide life-critical support that helps children and families learn, grow and heal. Rev. Lori explained that Baby Fold provides on campus and community programs with the goal that these families and children can eventually be self-sustaining.






