



Beginning with this article, we will focus on various parts of the Personal Discipleship Path plan each month in The Messenger. If you have not receive a copy of the plan for your personal use, you can do so from the office.

The personal plan begins, "One of our greatest hopes here at Marshall First United Methodist Church is to encourage and provide support for every individual to establish and maintain a deep connection with Jesus. We believe that following Jesus is the key to life. The Discipleship Path is not a map to an ending or finish line, but the pathway for a lifelong journey of being transformed into a mature disciple of Jesus Christ who embodies God's great love and presence in all aspects of life."

How is our connection with Jesus? How are we growing as disciples of Jesus Christ? These questions take us to the core of knowing and serving God. While there are many good things we do as believers and as a church, this is at the center. We realize that such a spiritual journey is a lifetime venture.
